



## CAYMAN ISLANDS GOVERNMENT

The Cayman Islands Government is currently inviting applications for the following posts within the Legislative Drafting Department:

### Legislative Counsel x 2

CI\$72,240 - CI\$97,176 per annum

The Legislative Counsel posts will be responsible for the drafting of clear, unambiguous and relevant legislation, both primary and secondary. These roles will involve the analysis of all legislative policies, ensuring that they are translated, by way of legislative drafting, into legislation to enable Government to carry out its functions.

The Legislative Counsel will advise Ministries on the methods available to achieve their policies, Government Departments on statutory interpretation, and advise the Attorney General, other Official Members and Ministries on proposals for legislation.

Applicants must:

- be a qualified Solicitor, Barrister or Attorney-at-Law;
- possess a diploma or Masters of Law in legislative drafting;
- be able to demonstrate an advanced level of the English language;
- have an ability to assimilate complex facts quickly; and
- be able to exercise sound judgement.

Applicants must have:

- at least five (5) years of post-graduate experience, four (4) of which must have been spent drafting legislation in a Government Department, Statutory Authority or other public body;
- a professional knowledge of statute law and legislative practices in the Cayman Islands, the UK and other jurisdictions; and
- a current general legal knowledge.

Depending on the successful candidates, the appointments would be on contract for two (2) years in the first instance, with the option to seek renewal. Leave entitlement will be twenty five (25) working days per annum and benefits include air passages, baggage/freight and relocation allowances, a non-contributory Government Pension Scheme and medical and dental coverage. **Please note that no income tax is payable in the Cayman Islands (CI\$1.00 = US\$ 1.20).**
