



CALC JAMAICA CONFERENCE - LOGISTICS

The next CALC Conference will be held in Jamaica on 13th to 15th May 2024.

This note provides logistical information to assist attendance at the Conference.

Conference Venue

The Conference will be held at the Ocean Eden Bay Resort, Trelawny, a 5-star all-inclusive adult only property with conference facilities.

Trelawny is located along the north coast of Jamaica equidistant between the popular tourist centers of Montego Bay and Ocho Rios. Its capital Falmouth is a tourist center with preserved Georgian architecture, the Good Hope Estate, Cruise ship port and duty-free shopping village, rafting on the Martha Brae, Swamp Safari and several other attractions.

The weather in May is on average around 30 degrees C (High) / 22 degrees C (Low).

Accommodation at Conference venue

Ocean Eden Bay has allocated a limited number of rooms at special rates for Conference delegates. The hotel has agreed to make these available until 28 March 2024 or until the allocated number of rooms are reserved, whichever is earlier.

Rooms are offered on an all-inclusive basis at the following rates. A link to make reservations at these rates will be provided to delegates on registration. **Note** – when you use the link for delegate rates, it may take up to 48 hours for the hotel to respond to the reservation request and up to a week for a payment link for a deposit for the reservation to be sent.

Rates quoted are US\$ per person per night on a single/double occupancy basis with potential for some room categories to be offered at triple occupancy rates. Rates are applicable for a minimum four nights/three-day stay. These rates are available to delegates for stays between 8 and 19 May as long as the conference dates of 12-16 May are included.

Alternative accommodation

While other accommodation is available across the north coast of Jamaica, we recommend that delegates reserve accommodation in the Ocean Eden or Ocean Coral Spring.

Transport to the Conference from other resorts will need to be organized at delegates own expense and the Ocean Eden will require delegates attending from outside the Eden or Coral Spring to pay a supplement of US\$95 per day to access the hotel.
