The Deputy Chief Parliamentary Counsel, under the direction of the Chief Parliamentary Counsel and in accordance with Ministerial policies, is responsible and accountable for providing a range of professional drafting services to Ministers, Ministries, Government Departments, and to His/Her Excellency the Governor, to ensure the delivery of Government's Legislative Agenda in a timely and efficient manner; The Deputy Chief Parliamentary Counsel is also responsible for providing expert legal advice on the Constitution and laws of Bermuda, and matters of statutory interpretation.

A minimum education qualification, the post holder must be called to the Bar in a Commonwealth jurisdiction.

A minimum of seven (7) years' relevant post-qualification experience in the drafting of legislation in a Commonwealth jurisdiction is required for the post. This experience must include one (1) year management at a senior level in a legal environment with the responsibility for the professional development of junior officers.
